Business Challenge

The web pages that host Atlantic Media's nationally acclaimed publications are under high global demand 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. With increasing web traffic to its online publications, Atlantic Media was suffering from server sprawl, rapid storage growth, and lack of a server failover solution. To address these challenges they decided to deploy a server virtualization solution to simplify their compute infrastructure and a shared storage system that could grow easily, provide simplified management, and integrate seamlessly with VMware vSphere to support the company's disaster recovery initiatives.

Technical Challenge

Before the virtualization project, Atlantic Media's legacy web infrastructure consisted of individual physical servers with internal direct attached storage. With the servers isolated from each other, information from one server could not be shared across systems and if a server failed there was no failover for disaster recovery.

Dave Mouyal, Network Systems Administrator for Atlantic Media felt like he was living on the edge, one server issue away from a disruption in service. Dave's goal was to consolidate his servers to reduce complexity and footprint in the data center, add server failover capability for redundancy and reduce his workload. Atlantic Media's next storage system had to be simple to manage, simple to setup, accessible to multiple servers, grow as needed, provide for server failover, and be within the budget.

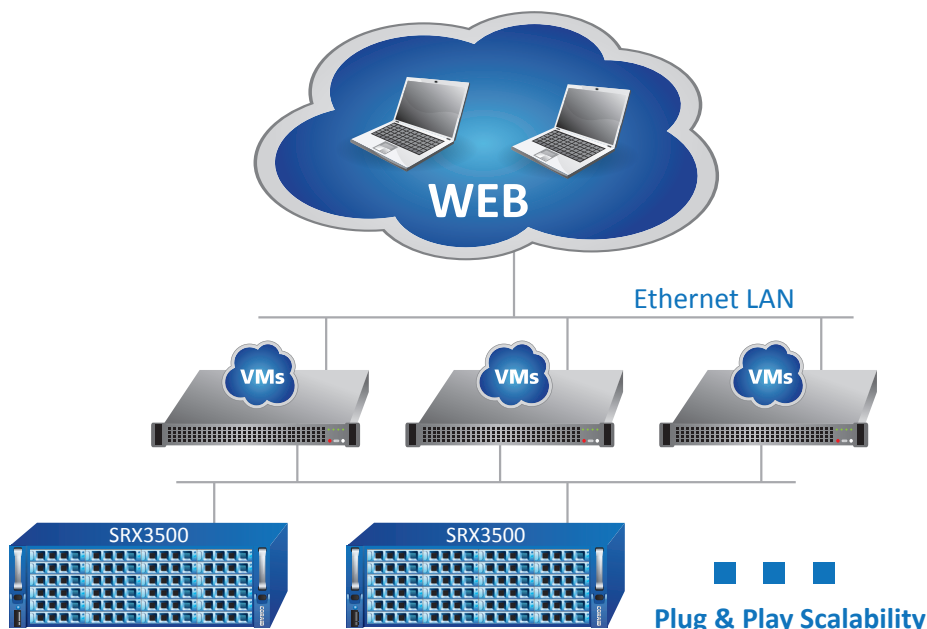
Solution

To achieve these requirements, Atlantic Media deployed two Coraid EtherDrive SRX3500 Ethernet SAN disk arrays to provide a shared storage solution for its VMware vSphere servers. Atlantic Media had explored other storage options including Fibre Channel and iSCSI solutions but the price and complexity of these systems were prohibitive.
